The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website.

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2019 Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge. Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, 27th-29th September 2019. Arena UK. Lincolnshire No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

Class 1 OPEN YOUNG STOCK 3 YEARS & UNDER

Rosettes for best yearling, 2 year old, 3 year old and mare and foal. To be judged on conformation, overall appearance and type

Class 2 OPEN BEST CONDITIONED HORSE OR PONY/TSR Qualifier

To be judged on overall health and condition.

Class 3 OPEN IN HAND PIEBALD/SKEWBALD

Qualifier for BSPA / Equifest In Hand Piebald / Shewbald. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their rules & conditions

Class 4 UNUSUAL COLOURED/ TSR QUALIFIER

Roans, duns, spotted

Class 5 BEST YOUNG HANDLER

To be run as one class but judged as separate aged categories – 10 and under, 11 – 16 years

REGISTERED AND UNREGISTERED OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Class 6 OPEN TO IN HAND M&M SMALL BREEDS -TSR Qualifier

Qualifier for Spillers / Equifest Mountain & Moorland In Hand Championship.

Ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A,B. Open to unregistered small breeds but only Registered ponies only would qualify for Equifest. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age

Class 7 OPEN TO IN HAND M&M LARGE BREEDS - TSR Qualifier

Qualifier for Spillers / Equifest Mountain & Moorland In Hand Championship. Ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest Welsh CD. Open to unregistered large breeds but only Registered ponies only would qualify for Equifest. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

Class 8 IN HAND THOROUGHBRED - ROR

Blemishes and scars will not be marked down. Any age.

Class 9 IN HAND RESCUE HORSE OR PONY

Any breed/type. Any age.

Class 10 IN HAND PLAITED, HOGGED AND TRIMMED

Any breed/type/colour. Any age.

Class 11 IN HAND TRADITIONAL/NATIVE TYPE

Any breed/type/colour. Any age.

Class 12 OPEN IN HAND HORSE OR PONY

Any breed/type/colour. Any age.

To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories: Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20–24 years) & Pre-Veteran (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height.

Class 15 **CONDITION AND TURNOUT – OPEN**

Class 16 OPEN SHOW PONY LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN Both TSR qualifiers

To be run as one class. **Please note**: the first 2 highest exhibits not already qualified from each section for both Lead Rein and First Ridden will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground in 2019.

The Milner Family / Equifest Show Pony Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their **8**th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only

The Coles Show Team / Equifest Show Pony First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years & over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their **10**th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 17 **OPEN RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES AND RIDDEN SHOW PONIES Both TSR** qualifiers.

To be run as one class. **Please note**: the first 2 highest exhibits not already qualified from each section for both Lead Rein and First Ridden will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground in 2019.

Equifest Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

KBIS / Equifest Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 18 RIDDEN COBS AND RIDDEN HUNTERS Both TSR qualifiers.

To be run as one class. **Please note**: the first 2 highest exhibits not already qualified from each section for both Ridden Cobs and Ridden Hunters will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground in 2019.

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age Nupafeed/ Equifest

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Black Country saddles/ Equifest

Class 19 RIDING HORSES -TSR qualifier

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cm. Riders any age.

Nupafeed/ Equifest

Class 20 UNUSUAL COLOURED - TSR qualifier

Roans, duns spotted

Class 21 RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 year old & over. Riders any age.
BSPA / Equifest

Class 22 OPEN RIDDEN M&M SMALL BREEDS – TSR qualifier

Ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland Welsh ABCD. Open to unregistered small breeds but only Registered ponies only would qualify for Equifest Mountain and Moorland open ridden championships.

Class 23 OPEN TO RIDDEN M&M LARGE BREEDS – TSR Qualifier

Ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh ABCD. Open to unregistered large breeds but only Registered ponies only would qualify for Equifest Mountain and Moorland open ridden championships.

Class 24 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the nose band. Cavernome Alliance UK/ Equifest.

Class 25 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

The Jungle Hut/ Equifest.

Class 26 RIDDEN THOROUGHBRED / ROR

Blemishes and scars will not be marked down. Any age.

Class 27 RIDDEN RESCUE HORSE OR PONY

Any breed/type. Any age.

Class 28 **EQUITATION RIDER** – 16 years and under **TSR** Qualifier

Class 29 **EQUITATION RIDER** – 17 years and over **TSR** Qualifier

Class 30 CONCOURS de ELEGANCE

Riders any age. Horse and ponies of any height, type and breed.

CHAMPION & RESERVE for classes 14 – 30. First and second prize winners

Class 31 MINI WORKING HUNTER PONY - fences not exceeding 30cm

Class 32 MINI WORKING HUNTER HORSE - fences not exceeding 45cm

Class 33 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY – fences not exceeding 50cm

Class 34 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter pony, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh A, B, C or D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age. Fences not exceeding 55/65cm.

Class 35: NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE – Fences not exceeding 70cm

Class 36: **OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONIES**

Working Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride. Fences not exceeding 70cm.

Class 37: **OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE**

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders of stallions to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 90cm.
